

BUSH MUSIC CLUB inc.

The Bush Music Club was formed in 1954 to promote awareness of Australian folk traditions. The Club does this by collecting, publishing and popularising our traditional songs, dances, music and folklore. Contemporary compositions in the traditional style are also encouraged.

Workshops: Dance workshops and Instrument workshops are held each week to teach and encourage anyone interested in learning how to sing, play or dance in the bush style.

Bush Dances: Are run monthly at Beecroft and, possibly, some other suburban locations. Dances are taught and called and are easy to do ... and fun! Discounts for groups of 20 or more.

Colonial Balls: Several Colonial Dress Balls are held annually. Tickets are often pre-sold (and may sell out well in advance). Generous concessions are available to Club Members.

Concert Party: The Concert Party gives musicians valuable experience in public performance. Concert Party may perform for appropriate charities or community groups for a nominal fee.

Retail: The BMC operates a retail service with books, tapes and records available to members at Club Functions. A mail order service is available. Substantial discounts for Club members.

Publications: The BMC is active in publishing material relating to Australian folk music; songbooks, music, broadsides, dance music, dance manuals and specialist publications. Recordings on CD and cassette are also available. Some of the Club's past publications include:

Singabout - Selected Reprints; the *Bush Dance* series of Tune Sets, Dance Instructions and CD set and Mike Waters' Dance Book *Ten Years Down the Track*.
